The lots shall, immediately upon the fall of the hammer, be at the sole risk and expense of the respective purchasers, who shall, when required, give in their names and addresses and pay in cash a deposit of 25 per cent. or such further sum as the Auctioneer may demand; and any deposit so paid shall be deemed paid upon and applicable towards payment for all or any of the lots which may be bought by such purchaser.
